### Cayman Islands NGOs address the UN C24

A local delegation from the Non-Governmental Organisations (NGOs) Constitutional Working Group addressed the United Nations (U.N.) Special Committee of 24 (C24) on Decolonisation on Wednesday, 16th June in New York City and appealed to the C24 to introduce educational programmes to inform the people of the Cayman Islands and other Non-Self-Governing Territories of their options for self-determination in their relationships to their Administering Powers and the development of their constitutions. The delegation announced plans to host an Overseas Territories Constitutional Forum in the Cayman Islands in September and sought the C24's assistance with funding and sourcing of experts. They appealed to the C24 to reject the attempts by Her Majesty's Government (HMG) to de-list the Cayman Islands from the list of Non-Self-Governing Territories without any clear evidence that such action is in keeping with the democratically expressed wishes of the people of the Cayman Islands.
